I had the pleasure and privilege of helping out at a Thanksgiving Day luncheon for homeless people in downtown Long Beach this past week. I brought my keyboard and, shortly after setting up and starting to play, a woman named Lina approached and started singing along with me. She had an absolutely angelic voice, truly gifted by God. After we'd done a couple tunes, she asked if I knew the old Gospel song "Precious Lord." I told her I did. so I started playing and once again Lina sang. This song evidently was very meaningful to Lina; as she sang the lyrics, Precious Lord, take my hand, lead me on, let me stand, I am tired, I am weak, I am worn...Through the storm, through the night, lead me on to the light, Take my hand, Precious Lord, lead *me home*" she began to weep. It was an incredible moment. I was dimly aware that a number of the people who were seated and eating their meals were intently watching Lina, and I felt moved to tears myself. When she finished singing, there was appreciative applause, and she disappeared into the crowd of people. Please pray for Lina and for people like her who are hurting.
